

PET REGULATIONS – 2027

Camping de Keralouet – Lesconil

To ensure everyone's comfort, safety and peace of mind, pets are accepted only under the following conditions.

DECLARATION AND PRIOR APPROVAL

- Every pet must be declared before the start of the stay.
- Pets are accepted only with prior approval from the campsite management.
- Without explicit approval, the campsite reserves the right to refuse the booking or access to the campsite.
- Visitors' pets are not permitted.

PETS ACCEPTED AND NOT PERMITTED

- Dogs and cats only.
- Maximum weight: 12 kg (unless agreed in advance).
- Category 1 and 2 dogs, as well as guard or security dogs, are not permitted.
- The campsite may refuse any animal considered aggressive or dangerous.

ACCOMMODATION CONDITIONS

- Maximum 1 pet per pitch or accommodation unit.
- An up-to-date vaccination record is compulsory and must be presented on request.
- The pet must have its own bedding (basket, blanket, cushion, etc.).
- Pets are not permitted on beds, sofas, cushions or bedding.

LIFE ON THE CAMPSITE

- Pets must be kept on a lead at all times.
- Daily walks and toilet needs must take place outside the campsite; owners must carry waste bags.
- Pets must never be left alone on a pitch or in accommodation.
- No access to play areas, the swimming pool or sanitary facilities.

CLEANLINESS AND CHECK-OUT INSPECTION

- Particular attention will be paid during the check-out inspection to the cleanliness of the accommodation, blankets, bedding and sofas.
- Any damage or lack of cleanliness may result in an additional charge or retention of all or part of the security deposit.

RESPONSIBILITY

- The owner is fully responsible for their pet and for any nuisance or damage it may cause.
- The campsite accepts no liability for incidents involving a pet.

! FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE RULES MAY RESULT IN REFUSAL OF ACCESS OR EXPULSION FROM THE CAMPSITE.

These pet regulations supplement the Internal Rules and General Terms and Conditions of Sale of Camping de Keralouet.
